

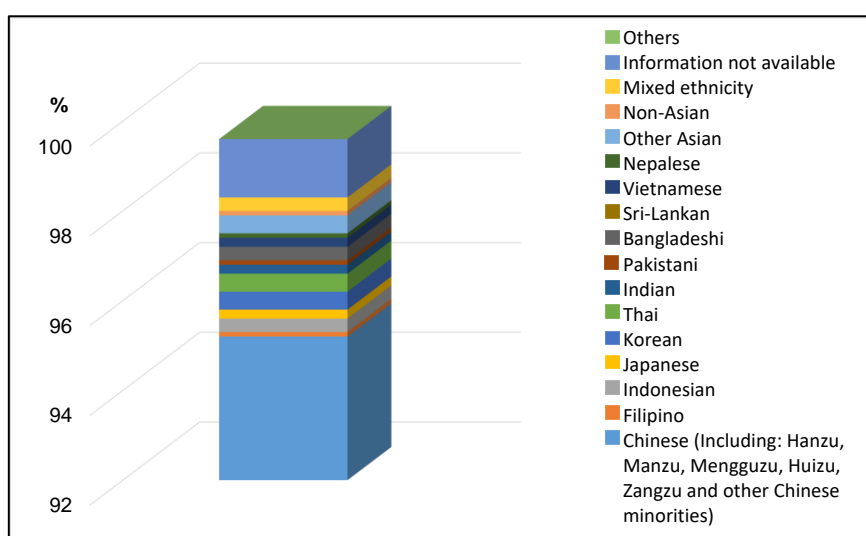

Summary of Key Findings from the Entry Class Questionnaire 2022

Since 2012, the Centre for Learning Enhancement And Research (CLEAR), the Colleges, the Office of University General Education (OUGE) and the Office of Student Affairs (OSA) have worked in a concerted effort to consolidate several sets of questionnaires to give a comprehensive set of “Entry Survey” for new students. The consolidated Entry Survey is named the “Entry Class Questionnaire (ECQ)”. The information collected by ECQ facilitates the units of CUHK to provide quality education and services to CUHK students.

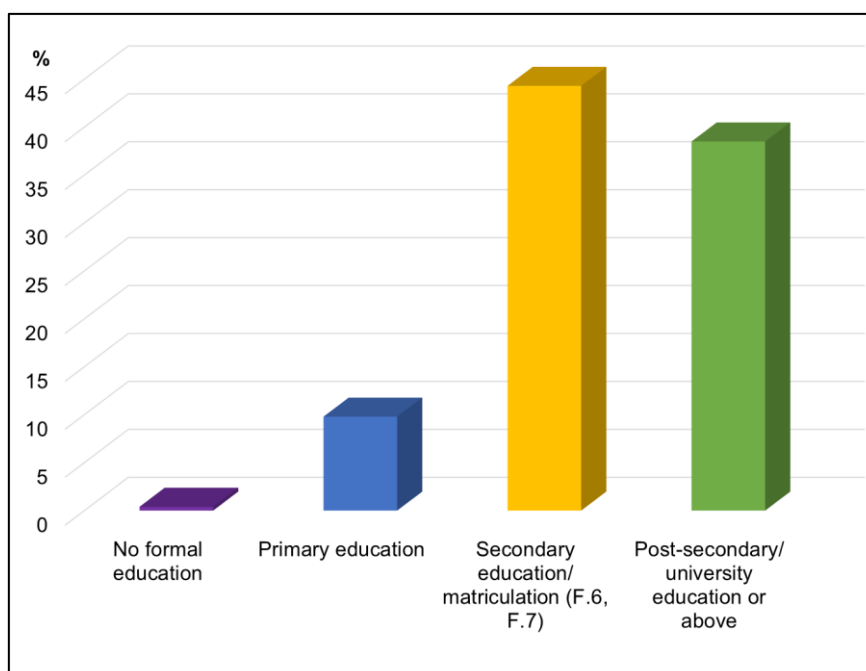

1. Ethnicity

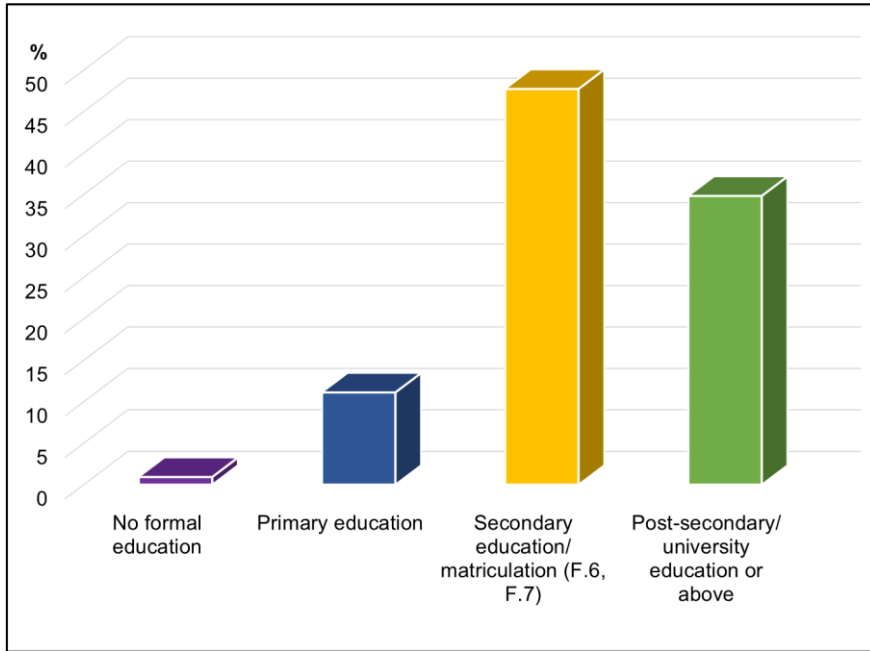


2. Highest educational attainment

(i) Father

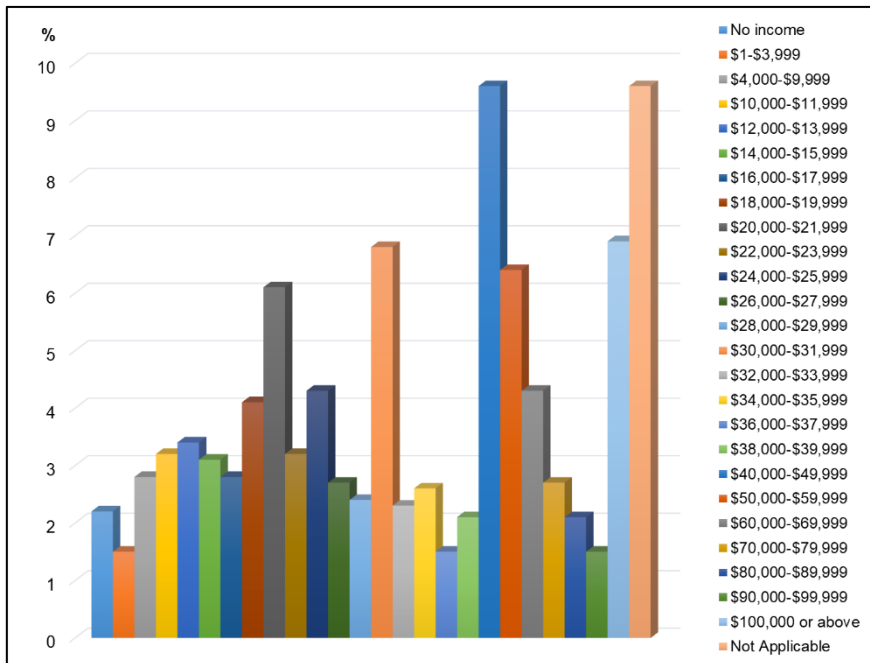


(ii) Mother

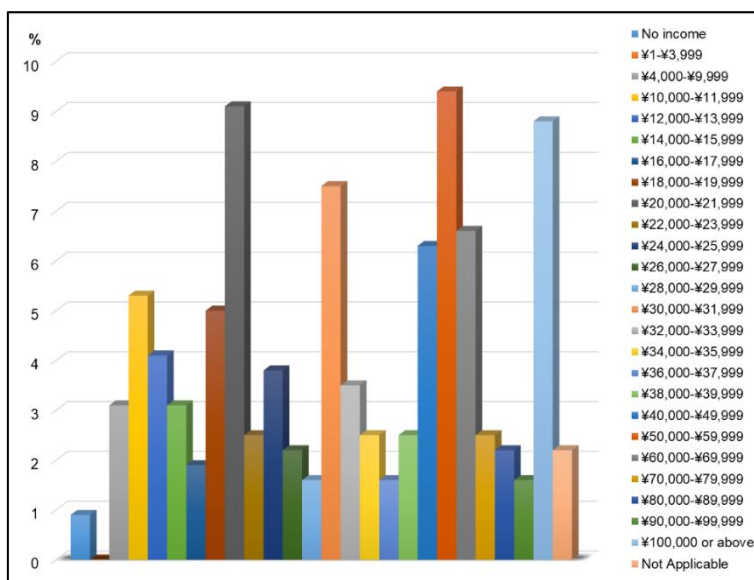


3. Monthly Income

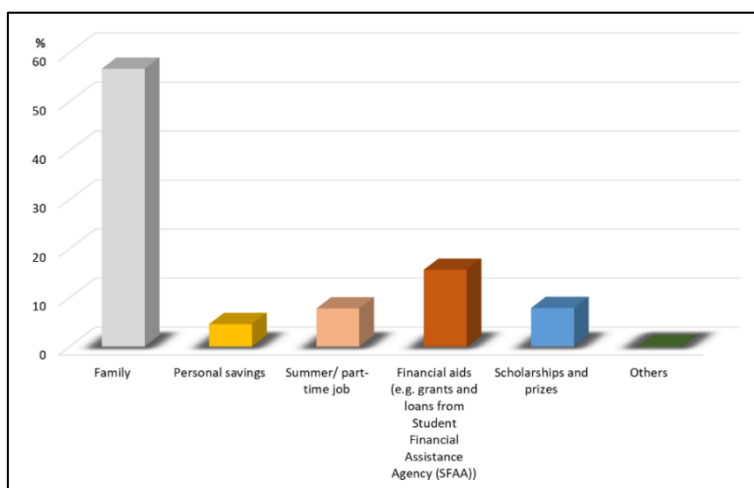
(i) Monthly household income (HKD) (for “Local student” or “International student”)



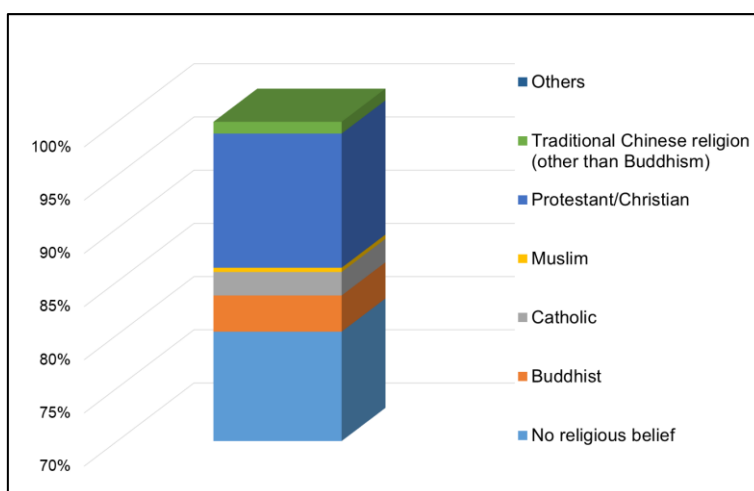
(ii) Monthly household income (RMB) (for “Mainland student”)
